## **Endorsement read by Edwards JA**

- [1] In this case, the court is of the view that there has been a miscarriage of justice given the state of the identification evidence, the credibility of the complainant and the inadequate treatment of these issues by the learned trial judge.
- [2] In the premises, the convictions are unsafe and cannot stand.
- [3] The order of the court, therefore, is that:
  - (1) Leave to appeal conviction is granted to each appellant.
  - (2) The hearing of the application for leave to appeal conviction, in respect of each appellant, is treated as the hearing of the appeal.
  - (3) The appeals against conviction and sentence are allowed.
  - (4) The convictions are quashed and sentences set aside. Judgment and verdict of acquittal is entered in respect of each appellant.
