

PRACTICE DIRECTION – COURT OF APPEAL – No. 1/06

Documentary exhibits in the Resident Magistrates' Court

This practice direction is issued by the President with the concurrence of the Judges of the Court of Appeal.

- (1) Each documentary exhibit to be submitted for use at the hearing of an appeal in the Court of Appeal must be copied and a copy placed (tied in) in each bundle. Each of such copies must be enclosed in an envelope.
- (2) No notation or writing shall be made on any documentary exhibit. Any such notation is a tampering with and a defacing of the said exhibit. That is undesirable.
- (3) Numbering of such exhibits shall be effected by numbered tags (small bits of paper) stapled or pinned to the exhibit.
- (4) Exhibit numbers shall coincide with the numbering on the list of exhibits.
- (5) This practice direction shall come into force with immediate effect.

Contents and format of index of appeals (civil and criminal) from the Resident Magistrates Courts.

This practice direction is issued by the President and Judges of the Court of Appeal.

TO: All Clerks of Courts, Assistant Clerks and Court Administrators

Attached are specimens of the documents and the format of the relevant indices which should be prepared and transmitted to the Court of Appeal for hearing of the appeal.

These are for guidance and should be followed, with any necessary modification required thereof.

The status of the appellant must be indicated on the backing of the appeal papers, namely:

- (i) whether or not he is in custody and if so where,
- (ii) if fined, whether it was paid, or
- (iii) if he is on bail, and if so, the bail bonds or commitment must be attached.
